Note: Elisabeth Price was b 23 Aug 1683 at Northampton, MA bur 4 Nov 1716 Montréal m 1st 6 Dec 1703 Deerfield, MA Andrew Stevens, an Indian. Her husband was killed in an Indian raid and she was carried away as a captive of war 11 Mar 1704 from Deerfield to Canada. Being ransomed she was bp 25 Apr 1705 Montréal m 2nd there 3 Feb 1706 John Fournneau dit Brindamour, b 1679 parish of St Michel city of Limoges province of Limousin, France son of James Fournneau and Margaret Govillac Peter Casse dit St Aubin became a "voyageur" and trader between Montréal and Detroit. Some years after his marriage he settled on a farm at the Grand Marais on the North East Coast of Detroit

He had promised to marry ROSALIE LOUISA ROBERTJEANNES, b 11 Dec 1778 Assumption Sandwich dau of Robert Jeannes and Catherine Réaume. This engagement was annulled and by legal articles of agreement of 15 May 1810 provisions were made concerning the temporalities of the interested parties m 15 Jan 1811 Detroit before a civil magistrate BASILIDE CAMPAU, b 30 Dec 1787 Detroit bur 9 Mar 1870 Mt Elliott Detroit dau of John Baptist Campau and Mary Catherine Boyer.
